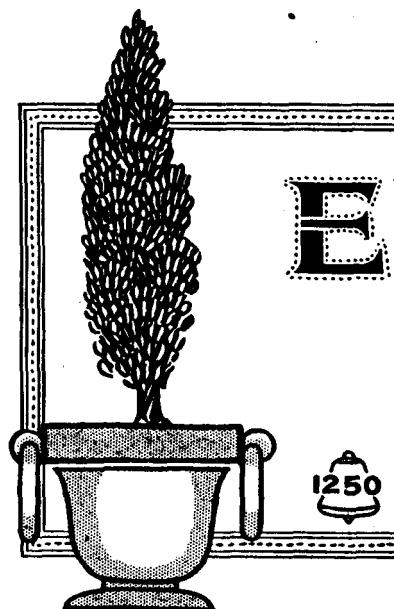
Another from NEW YORK
